

Your property is subject to flooding – get prepared!

Here's what you can do:

- Know your hazard. Determine your flood zone, download the flood safety brochure, and email questions on the Planning Department Flood Information page: http://www.sccoplanning.com/PlanningHome/Environmental/FloodInformation.aspx
- Get flood insurance. Take the One-Step Flood Risk Profile and find an agent at https://www.fema.gov/national-flood-insurance-program
- Prepare for flooding. Find sandbag locations at http://www.dpw.co.santa-cruz.ca.us/Portals/19/pdfs/Roads/SAND%20ANDW20SANDBAG%20LOCATIONS.pdf

- If flooding occurs, turn around, don't drown
- > **Maintain** riparian vegetation to prevent erosion, which can worsen flood hazards
- Don't dump in the storm drains they drain to the Monterey Bay
- Before you build, grade or alter structures on your property, contact the Permit Center to determine permit requirements: http://www.sccoplanning.com/PlanningHome/PlanningDepartmentLocationandHours.aspx
- Consider elevating or relocating your HVAC equipment, water heater, and electrical service panel to protect against flood damage and reduce your flood insurance premium

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
