## MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

## Project: Jose and Rodriguez Subdivision APN(S): 026-111-01 and -16

**Project Description:** Demolish the existing buildings and divide two parcels of approximately 2.88 acres into 20 parcels, with common areas for access, parking, and landscaping, and to construct 20 single family dwellings. Dwellings would be two stories in height with a range of size from 2,200 to 2,800 square feet in floor area. Each unit is proposed to include a two car garage and the site would accommodate an additional 32 uncovered parking spaces, for a total of 72 off-street parking spaces, in compliance with County Code requirements for residents and guests.

Project Location: The project site is located at the southeast corner of Rodriguez Street and Jose Avenue in the Live Oak planning area, at 1000 Rodriguez Street in unincorporated Santa Cruz County.
